ORDER RE CONSOLIDATION

The instant petition seeking a writ of prohibition was filed on February 22, 2011, after Respondent commenced proceedings in the lower court Case No. CV 11-10, *In re: The Constitutionality of NCA 10-173, NCA 10-199 and NCA 10-200*. In the underlying proceedings, then-Principal Chief Ellis sought declaratory and injunctive relief and a citation for contempt against Petitioner for alleged contemptuous legislative interference with executive nomination and appointment authority vested exclusively in the Principal Chief by the Muscogee (Creek) Nation Constitution. Respondent set an evidentiary hearing for February 23, 2011, and ordered Petitioner to appear and show cause why Petitioner should not be punished for contempt of court. To date, the instant petition for writ of prohibition remains pending.

Petitioner is also a party to Case No. SC 11-09, Muscogee (Creek) Nation National Council v. Tiger. SC 11-09 presents a final order appeal filed at the conclusion of lower court proceedings in CV 11-10, which is the same separation of powers dispute that underlies the instant petition. Although underlying proceedings are concluded in CV 11-10, our present consideration of the relief originally sought by Petitioner instructs that the petition for writ of

prohibition cannot properly be deemed moot due to the unique procedural history of the

underlying dispute. We note, however, that SC 11-09 presents questions of law and fact that

encompass all issues presented by the instant petition.

Under M(C)NCA Title 27, Appendix 2, Rule 6.F., this Court may, sua sponte,

consolidate separate actions and lack of a motion or stipulation from either party is no

impediment if relevant considerations warrant consolidation. We have previously exercised such

discretionary authority only where consolidation would promote the interests of judicial

economy, efficiency and convenience. Here, we readily confirm that consolidation promotes

judicial economy, efficiency and convenience and is unlikely to yield any countervailing

inconvenience, delay, prejudice or expense for the parties involved.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, pursuant to M(C)NCA Title 27, Appendix 2, Rule

6.F.; Case No. SC 11-01, Muscogee (Creek) Nation National Council v. Moore, be

CONSOLIDATED with Case No. SC 11-09, Muscogee (Creek) Nation National Council v.

Tiger.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Case No. SC 11-01, Muscogee (Creek) Nation

National Council v. Moore, be ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any future filings in these consolidated proceedings

be made exclusively in Case No. SC 11-09, Muscogee (Creek) Nation National Council v. Tiger.
