CLASSIFICATION: #37. TRIBAL GOVERNMENT

A LAW OF THE MUSCOGEE (CREEK) NATION REPEALING MCNCA TITLE 37 § 2-901, ENTITLED "Comprehensive Annual Budget-Requirements for Inclusion with New Programs"

Be it enacted by the National Council of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation:

SECTION ONE. FINDINGS. The National Council finds that:

A. New programs can be effectively evaluated without the need to be operational for three years.


B. The process in place for review of Comprehensive Annual Budget ("CAB") is effective for review of new programs and whether not they will be included in the CAB.

SECTION TWO. REPEALER. MCNCA Title 37 § 2-901 is hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act shall become effective immediately upon proper approval and execution in accordance with the requirements of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation Constitution.

ENACTED by the Muscogee (Creek) National Council on this 28th day of April, 2018.




