A LAW OF THE MUSCOGEE (CREEK) NATION AMENDING MCNCA TITLE 14 § 1-802 ENTITLED "Release prior to trial"

Be it enacted by the National Council of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation:

SECTION ONE. AMENDMENT. This amendment shall be codified in Title 14, Chapter 1, of the Code of Laws of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation; provided that for purposes of codification of said amendment and its inclusion in pocket parts of the Code of Laws of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation, the Attorney General is hereby authorized: (1) to approve any changes related to the manner in which sections, articles, chapters and sub-chapters are designated consistent with the format in the Code of Laws published in 2010 by West Publishing Company; (2) to include footnoted references to the legislative history in said pocket parts to the Code of Laws and (3) to note in said pocket parts any editorial correction of minor clerical or grammatical errors in the following amendment, without further National Council approval:

SECTION TWO. AMENDMENT. MCNCA Title 14 § 1-802. B.4., is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 1-802. Release prior to trial

- B. Conditions. When such determination is made, the Judge shall, impose one or any combination of the following conditions of release which will reasonably assure the appearance of the person for trial and ensure public safety:
 - 1. Place the person in custody of a designated person or organization agreeing to supervise him;
 - 2. Place restrictions on the travel, association, or place of abode of the person during the period of release;
 - 3. Require the person to abstain from the use of alcohol or other substances and be subject to testing to ensure compliance during the period of release;
 - 4. For an amount not to exceed three times the maximum fine allowable for the crime(s) charged, Rrequire the execution of a bail bond with sufficient solvent sureties, or the deposit of cash in lieu thereof; or

5. Impose any other condition deemed reasonably necessary to assure appearance and public safety as required, including a condition requiring that the person return to custody at a specified hour.

SECTION THREE. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This Act shall become effective immediately upon proper approval and execution in accordance with the requirements of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation Constitution.


