CLASSIFICATION: #36. TAXATION AND REVENUE

A LAW OF THE MUSCOGEE (CREEK) NATION AMENDING MCNCA TITLE 36, CHAPTER 3, ENTITLED "MOTOR VEHICLE TAX AND LICENSE CODE"

Be it enacted by the National Council of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation:

SECTION ONE. AMENDMENT. These amendments shall be codified in Title 36, Chapter 3 of the Code of Laws of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation; provided that for purposes of codification of said amendments and its inclusion in pocket parts of the Code of Laws of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation, the Attorney General is hereby authorized: (1) to approve any changes related to the manner in which sections, articles, chapters, and sub-chapters are designated consistent with the format in the Code of Laws published in 2010 by West Publishing Company; (2) to include footnoted references to the legislative history in said pocket parts to the Code of Laws and; (3) to note in said pocket parts any editorial correction of minor clerical or grammatical errors in the following amendments, without further National Council approval:

SECTION TWO. AMENDMENT. MCNCA TITLE 36, §§, 3-103 and 3-105.A. are hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 3–103. Registration eligibility

A. Muscogee (Creek) Nation. The Muscogee (Creek) Nation shall register all eligible vehicles to which it holds title with the Muscogee (Creek) Nation Tax Commission.

B. Chartered communities. Any chartered community of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation which holds title to an eligible vehicle shall have the option to apply for registration of said eligible vehicle with the Muscogee (Creek) Nation Tax Commission, instead of registration with another governmental entity.

C. Citizens. Any Muscogee (Creek) Nation citizen who resides within the geographical boundaries of the State of Oklahoma ~~political jurisdiction of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation~~ and who holds title to an eligible vehicle shall have the option to apply for registration of said vehicle with the Muscogee (Creek) Nation Tax Commission, instead of registration with another governmental entity; provided that failure of such person to apply for registration of an eligible vehicle with the Muscogee (Creek) Nation Tax Commission or with another governmental entity within thirty (30) days after purchasing or obtaining possession of said motor vehicle or within twenty (20) days of expiration of the previous tag shall may subject said person to penalties as provided in

subsection B of Title 36, § 3-112. For purposes of this subsection only, the term “eligible vehicle” shall have the same meaning as defined under § 3-102.C, except said vehicle may be principally garaged within or outside the political jurisdiction of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation.

§ 3-105. Registration application

A. Documents. Each applicant for vehicle registration with the Muscogee (Creek) Nation shall present upon application the following documents:

1. The applicant's properly endorsed Muscogee (Creek) Nation Vehicle Certificate of Title; or an application for a Muscogee (Creek) Nation Vehicle Certificate of Title if the applicant has not previously obtained such Certificate-;
2. Valid United States state or Territorial driver's license or other documents prescribed by the Commissioner ~~showing applicant's residence within the boundaries of the political jurisdiction of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation;~~

SECTION THREE. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act shall become effective immediately upon proper approval and execution in accordance with the requirements of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation Constitution.

ENACTED by the Muscogee (Creek) National Council on this 30th day of April, 2022.


